Another Fire by Lightning.

"Robbery?"

One William F. Goettel, of this village, a short time since, representing to some of his native countrymen residing in the over-seer town that he was a man of property, purchased of them cattle amounting to \$2,500 or \$3,000, giving to payment his notes due in ten days. The cattle were driven to market, and last week he returned to Lowville. The notes coming due, the holders demanded their money, but they were told by this enterprising cattle speculator that he had got on a "sneak" at Syracuse and had been robbed of the entire proceeds of the sale somewhere between that city and Boonville, and consequently was unable to pay. That kind of coin not being a satisfactory liquidation for his paper, an arrest was made, and Goettel brought before Squire Murray to answer the charge of obtaining goods under false pretenses. The matter beginning to look serious to the man of property, he finally prevailed upon his father to take up his notes, providing his creditors would deduct ten per cent. from the amount, which they did.

William Goettel who keeps a beer and whiskey shop at the depot, in this village, was arrested at the instance of Sheriff Kinley, on Monday, for violating the excise law by selling beer on the Sabbath, and keeping a disorderly house. The evidence was overwhelming that the law had been wilfully violated, but the Sheriff and District-Attorney seeing what a political mistake the former had made, and fearful, lest the Democratic ticket should suffer this Fall for the want of votes, caused the matter down by letting the offender give bail on his own recognizance to appear at the County Court. The threatened rupture in their party in this county is therefore healed for the time being, and the country safe.

Edwin Miller, of West Martinsburgh, sends us the following receipt for the cure of cholera morbus, cholera infantum, the worst forms of dysentery so prevalent at this season of the year, and all derangement of the stomach or bowels, which he considers superior to any remedy extant for these diseases:

Directions for Making.

One drachm of pulverized turpentine, 1 do of salutarin, 1 do of peppermint, all put into 1 1/2 pints hot water; when cold, strain off and add 2 ounces loaf-sugar and 2 ounces French brandy.

Directions for Using.

For a dose, one or two tablespoonfuls once in one-half or three-fourths of an hour, until the pain ceases and the disease is evidently checked. Two doses will usually do the work; sometimes one dose of two spoonfuls is sufficient for children, and slight sickness of the stomach. Where there is no pain, a smaller quantity will answer.
