Sheep Shearing in Alexander.—Unprecedented weight of fleeces.

EDITOR OF THE TIMES:—The following is a correct report of a public shearing at C. Crossman's in Alexander, on the 8th inst. It is believed that Dixie and Rocky Mountain yielded heavier fleeces than were ever taken from any other two sheep of one year and four days' growth—and we think Genesee County may challenge the world to beat it.

On Monday, 8th inst., at Alexander, was appointed Chairman, Jas. G. Shepard, Secretary, W. L. Dickinson, Weigher, and L. Rice, W. Lincoln and F. Lincoln, Shearers.
