Destructive Fire in the Woods.—A large
and destructive fire in the woods on the farm
of Rufus Whipple, on the north and east
corners of Clarkon Corner. Twenty-five
hundred cords of four foot wood and a large
quantity of saw logs have been consumed.
The origin of the fire is unknown. The wood
was insured for three dollars per cord, and the
logs, chiefly oak, for ten dollars per thousand
feet. It was several times supposed the fire
was under control, but the extremely dry
weather enabled the fire to work and expand
more rapidly than was anticipated. The high wind of Sunday
morning helped the destructive element to rage
with untold fury. The flames burst over the
wood and were rendered nearly worthless, having
burned through a deep rich muck covering to
a hard clay soil.

Business Reviving.—If we judge from
appearances outside in regard to the business
